
Quality Reporting & CPT II Coding Opportunities

To support quality measure performance, care gap closure, and accurate reporting, we encourage providers to submit applicable **CPT II codes** when services are performed and documented during the Annual Wellness Visit.

Blood Pressure Control

- **3074F** – Most recent systolic blood pressure <130 mmHg
- **3075F** – Most recent systolic blood pressure 130–139 mmHg
- **3078F** – Most recent diastolic blood pressure <80 mmHg
- **3079F** – Most recent diastolic blood pressure 80–89 mmHg

BMI Documentation

- **3008F** – Body Mass Index (BMI) documented

Medication Reconciliation

- **1111F** – Medication reconciliation completed

Tobacco Use Screening

- **1036F** – Tobacco non-user documented
- **4004F** – Tobacco user documented

Depression Screening

- **3725F** – Depression screening completed and documented

Fall Risk Assessment

- **1100F** – Fall risk status documented
- **3288F** – Fall risk assessment completed

Influenza Immunization

- **G8482** – Influenza vaccination administered or previously received
